

# Quick Facts: Highlights of the ISAPS 2013 Statistics on Cosmetic Surgery

- There were more than 23 million surgical and nonsurgical cosmetic procedures performed worldwide in 2013.
- Botulinum Toxin, (including BOTOX®, Dysport and Xeomin) was ranked the most popular procedure overall.
- For the first time, Brazil has edged out the United States for the number one position when it comes to total surgical procedures performed. The United States continues to lead with the most surgical and nonsurgical procedures performed combined.
- The top five countries which performed the most surgical and nonsurgical procedures were the United States, Brazil, Mexico, Germany and Spain.
- 11,599,336 surgical procedures were performed in 2013.
- The cosmetic surgical procedures performed most frequently were:
  - Breast Augmentation (1,773,584 procedures)
  - Liposuction (1,614,031 procedures)
  - Blepharoplasty/Eyelid Surgery (1,379,263 procedures)
  - Lipostructure including lipofilling and stem-enhanced lipofilling (1,053,890 procedures)
  - Rhinoplasty/Nose Surgery (954,423 procedures)
- Brazil accounted for 12.9%, United States 12.5%, Mexico 4.2%, Germany 3%, and Colombia 2.5% of the surgical procedures.
- 11,874,937 nonsurgical procedures were performed in 2013 with the United States taking the lead for most nonsurgical procedures.
- The nonsurgical procedures performed most often in 2013 were:
  - Botulinum Toxin (5,145,189 procedures)
  - Fillers and Resorbable (3,089,686 procedures)
  - Laser Hair Removal (1,440,252 procedures)
  - Non-Invasive Facial Rejuvenation (1,307,300 procedures) and chemical peel, CO2 resurfacing, dermabrasion (773,442 procedures)
- The United States accounted for 21.4%, Brazil 5.5%, Mexico 3.4%, Germany 2.6% and Spain with 2.0% of the total nonsurgical procedures.
- Women had more than 20 million surgical and nonsurgical procedures, 87.2% of the total. The top five surgical procedures performed on women in 2013 were: Breast Augmentation, Liposuction, Blepharoplasty, Lipostructure and Breast Lift.
- The United States accounted for 15%, Brazil 14.9%, Mexico 3.3%, Germany 3% and Venezuela 2.5% of the total number of breast procedures performed worldwide in 2013.
- Men had more than 3 million surgical and nonsurgical procedures, 12.8% of the total. The top five surgical procedures performed on men in 2013 were: Rhinoplasty, Breast Reduction for Gynecomastia, Blepharoplasty, Liposuction and Otoplasty.
