## **Commitment to Aesthetic Education Worldwide®**



Interview with **Dr. Gustavo Abrile** Chair of the Residents Education & E-Learning Committee

The advancement of aesthetic plastic surgery is a vital part of what ISAPS stands for, and as a Society, it offers many educational opportunities for individuals in the specialty. Part of this commitment includes the **continued education of Residents** and aspiring young surgeons who are the future leaders of aesthetic plastic surgery. These individuals are the ones who will ensure that aesthetic plastic surgery continues to develop and prosper.

To that end, ISAPS offers several opportunities for Residents and is always looking to expand and upgrade its current programs. Most recently, we relaunched the **Expert Program** with an updated application process.

To further explore these initiatives, we interviewed Dr. Gustavo Abrile, Chair of the Residents Education & E-Learning Committee, who shares details on what Residents can expect when joining ISAPS.

# ISAPS: Why are Residents an integral part of ISAPS, and what is the importance of their role?

**Abrile:** Residents are eligible to receive a free ISAPS membership, and as such, we have assumed the role of helping them complete the medical education they have been receiving in their residencies of plastic surgery, cosmetic surgery, and aesthetics.

Residences worldwide lack a program that provides a 100% cosmetic surgery focus, and ISAPS does just that. We offer a standardized way to access knowledge, taking into account different countries and cultures.

The role of the Resident is the future of plastic surgery; hence the importance of educating, communicating, and sharing knowledge, creating a spirit of solidarity that induces homogeneous scientific growth.

#### ISAPS: What are some of the main benefits for ISAPS Residents, and why is it important for them to take part in the many programs offered?

Abrile: The main benefit that ISAPS Residents have is access to unconditional information and education. That is why the webinar discussions, where the focus is on the diagnosis and treatment of specific pathologies, take into account the many different latitudes of perspective.

Our Journal Club, for example, provides a presentation on the subject of a pre-selected scientific article by its author and a panel of experts. It offer the opportunity for a scientific update and a pleasant discussion focused on a key issues.

In both the Journal Club and Resident Webinars, the summoned Resident has an active role in the discussion, which gives them an amazing learning experience.

The ISAPS Fellowship Program, a specialized training program hosted by plastic surgeons from around the world, is another fantastic opportunity for Residents. For those Residents looking for a similar experience but with an intensive one-on-one training program in a chosen specialty, I suggest the Experts Program. The Residents who choose this option work alongside a plastic surgeon who stands out in a specific specialty area.

And finally, ISAPS has a vast online education platform,

allowing residents access to the latest information in our specialty, the APS Journal, and the online video library.

#### ISAPS: As we look forward to the ISAPS Olympiad Athens World Congress 2023, what is being offered for Residents?

**Abrile:** Active participation! Residents can be a part of the Congress by sending summaries of personal experiences or of the Plastic Surgery Service to which they belong.

The Congress will feature an open forum for the exchange of ideas focused on the diverse jobs of young and experienced plastic surgeons. It will be a genuine educational "competition" for aesthetic and cosmetic surgery Residents.

In addition, the day before, there will be a 4-hour Symposium for Residents attending the Olympiad Athens World Congress.

ISAPS: The application deadline for the Fellowship Program just closed and now the focus is on applications for the ISAPS Expert Program. How do these programs contribute to ISAPS' goals around Aesthetic Education Worldwide®? How are these programs unique to ISAPS?

Abrile: These programs all contribute to ISAPS' goals around Aesthetic Education Worldwide<sup>®</sup>. Residents and Associate Members are eligible to apply and can request a visit with one of our listed ISAPS Experts for a short visit to learn about a specific procedure and/ or technique. Visits could be anywhere from a few days to two months, depending on the Expert's availability and offers. Whereas the Fellowship Program is a threemonth commitment.

These programs are unique to ISAPS because they have the particularity of training young plastic surgeons to be part of a unique specialty in the world, with a very high quality and safety standard.

#### ISAPS: As Chair of the Residents Education & E-Learning Committee, what is your favorite aspect of being able to support Residents, and what advice do you have for them?

Abrile: I was a Resident twice in General Surgery and Plastic Surgery, and I have learned a lot from my teachers and, obviously, also from my fellow Residents. And every day, in the Plastic Surgery Department to which I belong, I continue to learn with them. So being able to share my knowledge and work alongside them is invaluable.

In summary, the constant commitment, coupled with permanent effort, allows us to belong to this great family that is ISAPS, which has a unique leadership in education in the specialty worldwide.



### **Patient Data Safety**

Exercising patient safety in our daily practice is a priority, but does it also extend to your patients' online data?

#### Electronic Safety Measures & Benefits

Administrative and operational safety is just as critical, especially since the trend is towards Electronic Health Records (EHRs) rather than the traditional paper processes from years past.

Many practices have patient information online since it offers many advantages and makes patient records more accessible for doctors and patients. There are many other benefits to EHRs, including more precise patient information with fewer mistakes, more coordinated and efficient care, easier tracking of results, and improved treatment planning.

#### Patient's Online Risks

While there are many benefits, like with most things, there are also disadvantages. The most apparent one is the security of the data itself since, without the correct security measures, you could be placing your patients at risk. Their records can be vulnerable to ransomware attacks, internet vulnerabilities, and insider threats, like negligent staff or former employees.

#### **Securing Your Data**

However, knowing the possible threats gives us the upper hand since being aware allows us to be cautious and take the necessary actions to prevent them from happening in the first place. Steps can be as simple as deleting unnecessary data and educating employees, to more complex solutions, including setting up secure wireless networks, encrypting portable devices, and setting up mobile device policies.

#### Front of Mind

So, while you may already be using an EHR option, or are deciding on which one to choose, remember to keep your patient's safety front of mind, just as you do in your everyday procedures.

### Palpable Nodules After Autologous Fat Grafting in Breast Cancer Patients: Incidence and Impact on Follow-up

Autologous fat grafting (AFG) is a promising breast reconstruction technique, following surgery. However, fat necrosis after AFG can cause palpable nodules, inducing anxiety and prompting additional investigations. We aimed to determine the occurrence rate and to identify the risk factors of palpable nodules in breast cancer patients prompting complementary explorations.
