ISAPS Continuing Education & 2024 Congress Forecast

As we get 2024 underway, we look forward to another active and educational year at ISAPS! This includes our upcoming **ISAPS World Congress 2024, Cartagena**, from **June 11-15**. The Scientific Program Committee has been diligently planning the program, and we can't wait to share it with you soon!

We had the opportunity to meet with ISAPS Education Council Chair and Program Director Dr. Ozan Sozer, who shared some highlights and what we can anticipate for the 2024 Congress.

ISAPS: Our society has become the gold standard for providing continuing education to its members in new procedures, techniques, and options in aesthetic and reconstructive plastic surgery. In this context, what can we look forward to in 2024?

SOZER: In 2024, ISAPS will continue online educational events, including our recurring Resident Webinars and Journal Clubs, which usually rotate every other month, so there will be at least one educational event each month. In addition, the ISAPS eMagazine covers special subject areas in each issue under our Monthly Educational Corner, and our quarterly ISAPS News features new techniques and procedures in every issue. To promote education, we are also continually adding to our Online Video Library, which features content from ISAPS Congresses, Official Courses, the L.I.F.T. Program, and various ISAPS webinars.

ISAPS: Attendees at the 2024 Congress will experience a full program covering the latest advancements in aesthetic plastic surgery for safe and effective aesthetic procedures and improved quality of life for all patients worldwide. What can they expect to learn in the masterclasses, and what are the main topics of interest? And what pre-congress live surgery courses are scheduled?

SOZER: We have already prepared an intensive program for the 2024 Congress in Cartagena. The day before the main meeting, we will have a pre-congress program, including live surgery, a **Residents' Symposium**, and a sculpture course given by Dr. Julio Fernandez.

The live surgery will include the following:

- state-of-the-art high-definition body contouring techniques
- new multiplane breast lift augmentation
- · advanced face lift operations

The main program will feature more than **350** faculty and over **250** high-quality abstracts will be presented by our members.


Any subject that you can imagine will be covered in this extensive program. We are also scheduling one day dedicated to non-surgical treatments and practice management, and we are looking forward to also having a live ultrasound teaching course given by Dr. Pat Pazmino.

ISAPS: On a personal note, what part of the program are you most looking forward to, and why?

SOZER: This is a very difficult question; it is like asking which of your children you love the most - they are all wonderful! We prepared the program with the same enthusiasm and detail for each separate subject. Regardless of whether

it is face, breast, body contouring, patient safety, non-surgical treatments, genital surgery, or transgender surgeries, the faculty and the lectures are equally excellent. Depending on where the attendees' interests lie, they will find very satisfying programs in all topics - there is something for everyone!



MONTHLY EDUCATION CORNER

Building Personal Power



In the heart of bustling Athens, the ISAPS Olympiad World Congress 2023 shone with a particular charm. We weren't just on the stage for sporting feats; it was a **melting pot of wisdom, knowledge, and science** delivered by all the speakers. However, hidden within the convention center's recesses awaited a **unique experience, the L.I.F.T. workshop** by Andy Craggs and Alex McLaren.

Close to the millennium-old history, marble, and ancient statues, we immersed ourselves in a day that promised more than medical lessons. It was a journey of personal and professional discovery, built upon the physical and emotional exhaustion that often occurs in plastic surgery, represented by the concept of "burnout."

Andy was the one who lit the initial spark, opening a dialogue about **internal leadership as a weapon against fatigue**. We delved into deep reflections, questioning the importance of leadership in our own lives and how its absence could be the seed of exhaustion. The need to enhance our skills, become more resilient, and face the unexpected with fortitude emerged as a means to balance our lives and careers.

Alex's voice rose following this revelation, guiding us through the intricate paths of effective communication. Through exercises and challenges, he showed us the strength of closeness and the influence born from the connection between people. Teams, we understood, learn better when united and in proximity.

But the real magic happened when the conversation leaned towards how we learn best. Amidst this reflection, contrasts arose between childlike freshness and adult caution. With their **natural bravery**, children embrace mistakes and compete without fear of judgment. In contrast, adults, especially in the medical field, **learn and analyze under the pressure** of evaluations and grades, losing the spontaneity of learning through error along the way.

The true essence was revealed when exploring communication with patients. Emotional connection, we understood, forged bonds, and became the cornerstone of doctor-patient interaction. "Storytelling" emerged as the tool that binds ideas, people, and experiences, ensuring that each encounter leaves an indelible mark.

Stories aren't mere narratives; they are woven with sequences, images, and emotions. Context is the key that unlocks doors to the perception of the event. We discovered that when telling a story, we don't just narrate it; we vibrate, live it, and recreate it mentally, immersing ourselves in the art of "Storytelling."

The day offered us knowledge and a question that resonated in every corner of our minds, "Why do we do what we do?" A simple query that sparked

endless reflections, constantly reminding us of the relentless pursuit of excellence, both in the professional and human realms. And so, amidst narratives and introspections, we concluded our journey through that workshop at the Athens ISAPS Olympiad World Congress, marking an important moment for the leadership program driven by our President, Lina Triana.
