When will I receive my CME certificate?

After completing the overall evaluation you will receive an email from cme@health.slu.edu, to the email address provided during registration, notifying you that your CME certificate is available for download.

How do I download my certificate?

The link to log-in and your username will be included in the email. Once you log-in, click on My CME, then click on Claim Credit.
