
The warmest of South American welcomes await you in Cartegena de Indias, a port city on Colombia's Caribbean coast. Cartagena is a magical blend of historic fortifications, modern infrastructure, cutting edge technology, elegant courtyards, fine dining, and glittering nightlife. It is Colombia's most-visited city and is also the country's biggest port. It's walled old town, El Centro, which was founded in 16th century, is a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Cartegena de Indias was an inspirational source for Gabriel Garcia Marquez, who in 1982 became Colombia's first Nobel Prize winner in Literature.

With a tropical climate, the city is also a popular beach destination and reachable by boat are Isla de Barú, with white-sand beaches and palm trees, and the Islas del Rosario, known for their coral reefs. In the evenings, the modern corporate zone and the Old Town are transformed - spectacular sunsets, refreshing sea breezes and a vibrant nightlife, where tropical flavors and a mix of cultures make for a unique gastronomic experience.



HISTORICAL HERITAGE OF HUMANITY

Port and Monumental Complex: Cartagena has the most extensive fortifications in South America. A zone system divides the city into three neighborhood: San Pedro, with the cathedral and numerous Andalusian-style palaces; San Diego, where merchants and the middle class lived; and Gethsemane, the 'popular neighborhood'.

The city is the sum of its incredible attributes and qualities: its colonial, republican and modern architecture, its cultural festivals, its outstanding gastronomic offer, its unique hotel and tourist infrastructure; and its multiple non-traditional spaces such as plazas, colonial mansions and fortifications that can only be described as unique.



Lastly, if you have any food allergies, be sure to always ask about the ingredients used in the meals you order.












































Cartegena de Indias offers a broad mix of accommodation from boutique hotels to luxurious 5-star high rise hotels.




















Within the region of Caribbean Sea, the city has easy access to many island complexes with their turquoise waters and white sandy beaches.
