### ACCESS TO ISAPS Mentoring

The role of a mentor can be critical to your success in this specialty where having the wisdom and guidance of another more highly experienced surgeon can provide support and open door. The ISAPS Mentor program will assign you a specific mentor to help assist you with possible rotations during your training, or connect you with their own network of colleagues and other highly motivated trainees. Your ISAPS Mentor can advise you which courses and meetings to attend, and once you've finished training they can be a sounding board to offer solutions for difficult plastic surgery cases regarding indications, best techniques, and in extreme cases even assist with the surgery itself. Mentor and mentee can connect via email or WhatsApp and have regular quick exchanges.
