ACCESS TO ISAPS FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM

The ISAPS Fellowship Program is designed for a stay of three months for ISAPS Resident and Associate Members. The intention is to get an intensive training in a broader field of aesthetic surgery. This format is applicable for residents as part

of their training in plastic surgery, but also after board certification within the first three years. The structure of such a teaching program is entirely up to the expert and local host.

ACCESS TO SPECIALIZED TRAINING WITH ISAPS EXPERT PROGRAM

The ISAPS Expert Program offers ISAPS Resident Members the opportunity to attend a specialized intensive one-on-one training program with a long-serving ISAPS

member who is recognized as being a leader in their field. The length and content of the training will vary and is at the discretion of the host surgeon.

ACCESS TO ISAPS MENTORING

The role of a mentor can be critical to your success in this specialty - where having the wisdom and guidance of another more highly experienced surgeon can provide support and open door. The ISAPS Mentoring program will assign you a specific mentor to help assist you with possible rotations during your training or connect you with their own network of colleagues and other highly motivated trainees. Your ISAPS Mentor can advise you which courses and meetings to attend, and once you've finished training they can be a sounding board to offer solutions for difficult plastic surgery cases regarding indications, best techniques, and in extreme cases even assist with the surgery itself. Mentor and mentee can connect via email or WhatsApp and have regular quick exchanges.
